



Clan na Gael Players are launching their first One Act Play-writing Contest. The purpose of the contest is to support and encourage emerging playwrights and to provide a stage for scripts that might not otherwise find one. Playwrights of all ages are encouraged to enter.

The contest is seeking original One Act plays of not more than 20 minutes in length.

All entries must be the original writing of the submitting playwright.

They may be written in any style, set in any historical time, geographic or imaginary location and contain any number of characters. Each must contain in the opening line: "things happened".

Scripts are restricted to plays that have not been produced, published or won other contests.

Only one script per playwright will be accepted.

Entries may be submitted starting May 1, 2011 and must be received at the Gaelic-American Club, 74 Beach Road, Fairfield, CT no later than July 31, 2011 at 8:00 pm to be considered.

The Winners will be announced in August 2011 and will receive a staged reading at the Gaelic-American Club during the Clan na Gael 2011 season.

Scripts must be typed in play format and bound. Binding must be 3-hole punched or clipped only, do not bind or staple the manuscript. We must be able to remove the pages to make copies. By submitting a copy of the script the playwright agrees to allow their work to be copied.

Each script must include the following:

Page 1 - The play title only

Page 2 - A brief synopsis

List of characters including gender and ages

Set requirements

All scripts must be accompanied by a Clan na Gael Official Contest Entrance Form. All entries will be handled with extreme care, but Clan na Gael cannot assume responsibility for lost or damaged scripts. It is suggested that playwrights retain copies of their scripts.
